Cape May County at a glance



PEOPLE

- 95,000 year-round residents with an estimated summer population of 812,000
- 4.9 percent of the people are under 5 years old
- 17.8 percent are under 18 years old
- 23.9 are over 65 years old
- Per capita income is \$33,499



Gerald M. Thornton has been the Director of the Cape May County Board of Chosen Freeholders since 2012. He previously served as Freeholder from 1976-1987 (three of those years as Director as well). He was elected again to the Board in 1995 and has served ever since. Director Thornton is the longest serving Freeholder in the history of Cape May County. He is the Director of Administration, Clerk of the Board, County Counsel, Emergency Management, Facilities and Services, Management Information Services, Purchasing, Special Projects, Treasurer's Office and Veterans' Bureau.

Director Thornton serves on the Executive Board of the New Jersey Association of Counties, working closely with them on issues affecting all residents of the State of New Jersey. Also, he has been an active and supportive member of many organizations in the county including American Legion Post 193, The Cape May County Union League, AARP, Villas Fishing Club, Local 18 AFL-CIO, and is a former member of Rotary & Optimist. Additionally, he is a former eight year member of the Board of Elections.

Following Hurricane Sandy, Director Thornton was appointed to represent the region on President Obama's Hurricane Sandy Rebuilding Task Force Advisory Group which was established through Executive Order. In 2012, he was presented with the Seven Seals Award for going above and beyond in his support for employees who serve in the military. In 2015, he was the recipient of the Southern New Jersey Freeholders' Association's "Southern Star" Award which recognizes members who have given distinguished service to their county and fostered a cooperative spirit among the eight member county governments and affiliated organizations.

Director Thornton attended Kellogg Community College and the University of Maryland Overseas Extension. An eleven-year veteran of the U.S. Air Force, he attended technical schools including Air Traffic Controller, Space Tracking and Telemetry, Automatic Radar, Management and Supervision and Non-Commissioned Officers Academy.

He is the proud father of two sons, Christopher and Mark, two granddaughters Kirby and Shelby and two grandsons Christopher David and Matthew Mark.

E. Marie Hayes was sworn-in on February 1, 2013 to fill the unexpired term of M. Susan Sheppard, Esq. on the Board of Chosen Freeholders. She was re-elected in November 2014 to her first, three-year term and will serve until December 31, 2016.

As Freeholder, she is the Director of Tourism & Public Information, Public Offices and Transportation overseeing the Board of Elections, County Clerk/Adjuster, Culture and Heritage, Fare Free Transportation, Library, Museum, Park/Zoo, Print Shop, Surrogate and Tax Board.

Freeholder Hayes is a voting member of the New Jersey Association of Counties and a member of the Southern New Jersey Freeholders' Association. Rita Marie Fulginiti was elected County Clerk in 2005, 2010 and 2015. She has been employed at the County Clerk's Office since 1985.

County Clerk Rita Marie Fulginiti is an election official responsible for the preparation of sample ballots, processing Mail-In ballots, filing candidates' nominating petitions and certification of countywide election results. She oversees the recording of documents pertaining to real property transactions in Cape May County. Fulginiti serves as County Historian and maintains an archive of precious land and judicial records dating back to 1692. The County Clerk is a U.S. Passport Agent for the county, provides vendor licenses to veterans and exempt firemen, Cape May County Veteran ID Cards, administers oaths to Notaries Public and performs wedding ceremonies. She also serves as County Adjuster, performing a human services role on behalf of patients committed to psychiatric institutions.

Fulginiti has an AA in Business Administration from Atlantic Cape Community College; is a Certified Public Manager through the New Jersey Department of Personnel Human Resource Development Institute in partnership with Fairleigh Dickenson University and has earned the Certified Public Official designation by the National Association of Clerk's Records, Election Officials and Treasurers, an affiliate of the National Association of Counties.

In November 2008, Gary Schaffer was elected to his first term as Sheriff of Cape May County. He was re-elected in 2011 and 2014.

The sheriff's office provides for courthouse security, as well as various county facilities including the Special Services School and the Park and Zoo. The sheriff maintains the county jail, conducts sheriff sales and issues deeds resulting from those sales. The sheriff officers track and arrest persons wanted on warrants, transport prisoners and sponsor various safety programs. The sheriff's department K-9 unit utilizes highly trained tracker, explosive and narcotic dogs for police related purposes. Also, the sheriff has the oversight of the Cape May County Animal Shelter.

Gary Schaffer has served the law enforcement community of Cape May County for 43 years. He served the Ocean City Police Department for over 25 years, retiring at the rank of Detective Lieutenant. Schaffer was Director of the Cape May County Public Safety Training Center for ten years.

Schaffer has an Associate Degree in Law Enforcement from Atlantic Cape Community College and a BS Degree in Criminal Justice from Stockton State College. He is a graduate of the New Jersey Chiefs of Police West Point Command and Leadership Program and the FBI National Academy 192nd session and a graduate of the National Sheriff Institute. (I.E. Atlantic City, Toms River, New Brunswick):

Take exit 11 Garden State Parkway South onto Crest Haven Road. Turn left on Crest Haven Road and go under Garden State Parkway. Turn left at light onto Moore Road (runs parallel to Garden State Parkway), take second right into parking lot. Building entrance is on the north end of lot near flagpole

FROM THE NORTHWEST

(I.E. Cumberland County, Camden/Phila.):

Route 55 South to end(becomes two-lane Route 47). Route 47 to Route 347 (bear left & follow main traffic flow at split). Route 347 becomes Route 47 again in approx. 8 miles. Left onto Route 83 South. Right onto Route 9 South. Left onto Crest Haven Road (county park and zoo on right). Once under the Garden State Parkway, make an immediate left onto Moore Road (runs parallel to Garden State Parkway). Take second right into parking lot. Building entrance is on the north end of lot near flagpole

FROM THE SOUTH:

FAMILY EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS

- Pre-plan your arrangements to stay with family or friends outside of Cape May County and outside of the Hurricane Impact Area.
- Establish an out-of-state friend to act as a contact for separated family members.
- Show each member of the household how to turn off water, gas and electricity. Consider neighbors who may need assistance.
- Gather valuable papers such as social security cards, birth certificates, deeds, titles, marriage and death records, wills, stocks and bonds, inventory of household goods, cash and credit cards. Keep items in an airtight container for easy transport.
- Post emergency numbers by telephones

PRE-EVACUATION ACTIONS

- Put together materials needed to take to a shelter such as prescription medications, special dietary food, specific medical information, personal aids, eyeglasses, hearing aids, etc.
- Fill your car with gas, check car battery and oil.
- Check flashlight and radio batteries.
- Make arrangements for your pets for a minimum of seven (7) days.

Official County Seal adopted in 1927

The History:

County records indicate that the first mention of the “County seal” was on February 6, 1838, when the Board of Freeholders asked Jeremiah Learning to make a seal for the County. There is no description of what type of seal it was or what it looked like. A County seal was not mentioned again in records until May 7, 1872, when the Director of the Board of Freeholders, Dr. Alexander Young, suggested that a new County seal be made as the old one was poorly made and should be destroyed. There was no description given of the appearance of this seal either.

On March 16, 1927, Freeholder Director Joseph G. Champion presented a design for an official County seal to the Board of Freeholders. The design had been made by architects Edwards and Green of Philadelphia. Champion wished to have the design installed in the floor of the new court house building on Main Street in Cape May Court House. The design was accepted and on May 1, 1927, this design became the official seal of Cape May County.

The Symbolism:

The boat is believed to represent the Half Moon, the ship of Henry Hudson, who “discovered” the cape and claimed it for the Dutch. The compass arrow indicates the position of the County. The symbols around the edge represent fish or whales which, along with the anchor, represent the County’s maritime commerce. The bee hive on the right is thought to represent County industry. The stack of books on the left represents learning or education. The cornucopia between the fish represents the agricultural bounty of the County. The last symbol at the bottom of the seal is a mystery symbol. The meaning of this symbol is unclear.
