2. Additions and Corrections to Minutes – Judge Sheppard

3. Administrator's Report – K. Raring Reported the following:

2019 Comprehensive County Funding-The County was awarded \$314,535 for 2019. The monies will fund the Probation Pathways, ISP and Station House Adjustment Programs. Grant award is waiting upon execution by the County and then will be forwarded to the state for final signatures. Grant award is not yet in JAMS- grantees will be advised when they can enter 1st quarter LOS.

YSC By-Laws: Proposed YSC By-Laws were emailed 2 weeks prior to the meeting for review. No additions or corrections were presented. J. Hance motioned to adopt the by-laws as presented. L. Marcy seconded. Motion was carried.

YSC Conflict of interest: Members that had yet to complete were provided forms at the meeting and executed by each member.

6. **Family Advocate Program Presentation** – L. Marcy reported on the “Doing What is Right Training” held on 3/21/19. Seminar was well attended with a diverse population. Parent focus group was held in the 1st quarter. The FSO will be presenting year 2 screenings of “The Kids We Loose” in the coming months, dates will be forwarded once determined.
7. **Probation Enrichment Update-** K. Raring reported that the program is waiting for grant documents to be executed by the State Judiciary. Once received the committee will meet to set up 2019 schedule.
8. **Old Business**
Recovery High School – K. Faldetta reported that the school is up and running and currently has 5 students. 3 from Lower Twp., 1 from Woodbine and 1 from Wildwood. Due to a fire at Cape Assist the school is temporarily located at the Church of Christ in Middle Township. The program is looking for off-site layers of support to provide students with after school activities and the summer for additional resources to support recovery.

A discussion was had on the utilization and services of County funded programs for Cape May County Youth. K. Raring advised members to email their questions, concerns and or suggestions and that the County would look into the matters presented for review.
