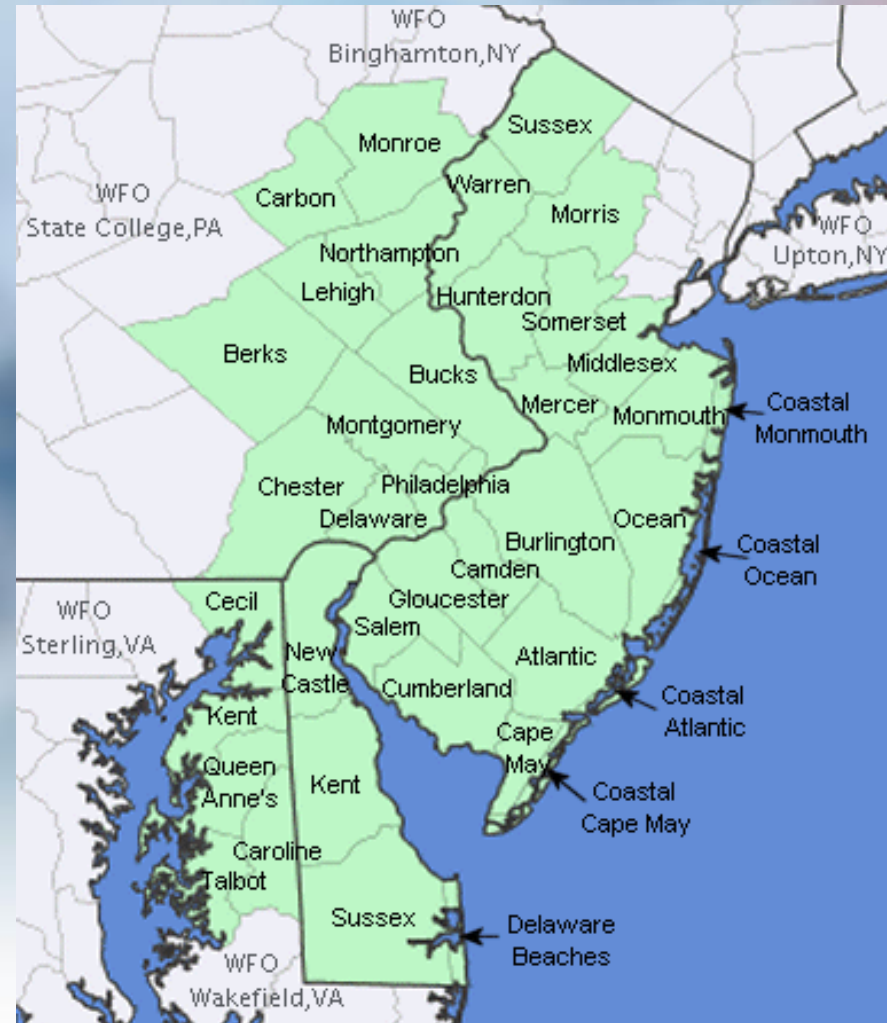

Changes from previous briefing

- **Sandy brought tremendous damage and devastation to our region over the past 36 hours.**
- **The worst weather from this storm has occurred. Weather conditions are steadily improving.**



Executive Summary

- Dangerous Coastal Storm Sandy has had a devastating impact on our region, with record coastal flooding, hurricane force winds, & very heavy rainfall.
- The worst weather is behind us as Sandy continues to move away from us.
- Coastal flooding will continue to subside, winds will continue to diminish, only light rain showers remain in the region today .
- Drier weather with cool temperatures will be the main weather story for the next several days as response & recovery efforts continue.
- If you need specific weather information for any particular location, you can put specific city, state location information on our website & receive a detailed forecast for that location.
