

ELIGIBILITY: Any artist age 60 or over, currently residing in Cape May County may submit **TWO ENTRIES**. **Entries must be original and should have been completed within the last three years.** Artwork shall not have been entered in the County Art Show before. Entrants may be of either professional or non-professional status and beginners are encouraged to participate as well.

* **PROFESSIONAL:** Persons claiming professional status are those who have (1) sold the type of art in the contest/exhibition commercially; (2) exhibited professionally and/or; (3) held membership in a professional artist guild or association.

* **NON-PROFESSIONAL:** Persons who do not meet any of the above criteria or are considered non-professional.

ARTWORK:

* All work must be the original creation of the artist (mounting, matting, and framing excluded). No kit paintings or copies of others' original art work will be accepted.

* Hanging craft or framed work, including photography, must be no more than 30" in all directions and no narrower than 10" including the frame.

* **Sculpture or 3-D craft may not exceed 20" in height, width or depth nor exceed 40 pounds in weight.**

* Any artwork exceeding these guidelines will be deemed ineligible for this exhibition.

* All participants are responsible for insuring their own works.

* Atlantic Cape Community College has requested the artist signature on their Disclaimer & Waiver form. There is 24-hour security at the college. Please bring in signed waiver when dropping off art work on June 4.

CATEGORIES: The following are categories of eligible work;

- **OIL Painting**
- **ACRYLIC Painting**
- **WATERCOLOR:** including gouache
- **PASTEL:** including pastel chalk, and oil pastel
- **WORKS ON PAPER (Drawing):** Includes hand-drawn work in mediums including charcoal, pencil, colored pencil, graphite, pen & ink.
- **SCULPTURE:** any work designed in 3-dimension, carved or constructed in any medium, abstract or figurative, painted or unpainted and as one piece only.
- **PHOTOGRAPHY:** including color, black & white or tinted photographs taken with a film based or digital camera.
- **DIGITAL/COMPUTER ART:** artwork generated or altered using computer graphics software (does not include digital photographs). Work must be entirely original, including the source.
- **MIXED MEDIA:** including collage and assemblage. Containing 2 or more media, no one which clearly predominates. **(PLEASE SPECIFY MEDIA)**
- **CRAFT: ONE-OF-A-KIND ORIGINAL CREATIONS ONLY, no craft kits, molds or wearable fiber art.**
- **PRINT:** includes all print forms including etching, linoleum block, lithograph, woodcut, monoprint, silkscreen, etc.
- *(Please keep any craft entry under 30" and you must be able to safely display it.)*

The artwork should be protected where necessary, with glass, Plexiglas, Mylar or other clear, protective material. **Plexiglass is required for any 2-D pieces over 24"**. While all possible care will be taken to safeguard the artwork, **the Division of Aging & Disability Services will not assume responsibility for loss or damages incurred to artwork, frames, or glass. Entry in the show signifies compliance with this waiver.**

TABLE TOP EASEL AND STANDS: Each exhibitor will need to furnish a means of displaying his own works on easels for table top display. All easels and stands must have your name securely fastened or written on it, where visible, to identify your property. They must be **sturdy and large enough** to support your entry; to avoid putting stress on your canvas. Easels with rubber tips on the legs are best to prevent your entry from sliding or falling.

NOTE: No free-standing easels will be accepted.

DELIVERY: All artwork must be delivered to Atlantic Cape Community College, 341 Court House-South Dennisville Rd., Cape May Court House on Tuesday, June 4 between 2-4 PM. (Please do not stay after you deliver your entries.)

Awards Reception: Will be held on Wednesday, June 5, 2019 with recognition of artists at 2PM. First, Second, and Third Place Awards will be given in the Non-Professional and Professional Categories. In addition, there will be a minimum of 20 Honorable Mention Awards and 3 Best of Show Awards.

All art work will remain on exhibit at the college until June 19th. Pickup time is between 10AM – 12PM. This exhibit will be open to the public Monday to Thursday until the 19th of June.

NOTE: Applications will not be accepted after May 24, 2019.

All participating artists are asked to please be present to receive recognition.
