

Part-Time/On-Call Toll Collector/Bridge Operator

The Toll Collector/Drawbridge Operator position is responsible for collecting tolls through toll lanes and operating mechanical and electrical equipment and control devices to open and close drawbridges while ensuring the safety of marine and vehicular traffic. This position is essentially in an outdoor work environment, subject to weather conditions. Candidates must have good mobility to walk up and down bridges, and good vision and hearing to be alert to traffic conditions. This position requires constant dealings with the public and therefore requires excellent customer service skills.

- We are seeking candidates that are available part-time/on-call, variable hours, locations and shifts, may include weekends, overnights, and holidays.
- Possible Shifts are 6:00am-4:00pm, 3:45pm-11:00pm, 10:45pm-6:00am, 11:00am – 8:00pm
- Payrate is \$12.45 per hour

Job Description Requirements

- Proficiently operate computer equipment such as touchscreen, mouse, Windows.
- Accurately classify vehicles, collect proper toll amounts and issue correct change.
- Accurately complete reports and logs.
- Speak and understand English proficiently.
- Operate electrical and mechanical equipment and control devices to open and close drawbridges while ensuring the safety of marine, vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
- Ability to operate and communicate with a marine radio
- Available to cover shifts as needed at five toll locations.

Minimum Experience Requirements

- High school diploma or GED.
- Required to possess and maintain a current/valid driver's license.
- Availability to work weekend, overnights and holiday hours based on business needs.
- Ability to safely walk across toll lanes and up and down bridges.
- Ability to express ideas and concepts clearly.
- Final candidates for this position will need to successfully complete a background investigation, which may include a criminal and credit check along with DMV.
- Corrected vision of 20/40 or better.
- Be able to distinguish red, amber, and green colors.
- Must be able to hear normal, and pass a screening test
- Must be at least 18 years old.

Skills Knowledge and Ability

- Must be able to effectively communicate in English on the VHF marine radio.
- Must be able to follow instructions.
- After employment, must be able to meet qualification as a trained bridge tender.
- Must have normal hearing and eyesight, including depth perception and freedom from color and night blindness.
- Must be available to work rotating shifts which may require working holidays and weekends.
- Work without close supervision.
- Learn the operation of all CMCBC operated drawbridges.
- Learn the regulations governing the operation of drawbridges.
- Learn and use proper radio-telephone procedures.
- Must have a valid phone number, a working cell phone or home telephone, and answer it.
